## Keynote Speaker

The Rev. Barbara S. Peter, H. R., is a graduate of McCormick Theological Seminary, ordained to Parish Ministry in 1991. She is also a graduate of San Francisco Theological Seminary as a Spiritual Director and was honorably retired by the Presbytery of Chicago from Southminster Presbyterian Church, Arlington Heights, Illinois.

At Southminster, Barbara was Director of the Center for Reformed Spirituality and continues to provide both individual and group spiritual direction. As a member of the Committee on Ministry, she taught the discernment process to Sessions and Pastoral Nominating Committees.

Her Hoosier roots include birth at Bluffton, near both grandparents' farms in Huntington County. She was educated in the Indiana public school system and earned both Bachelors and Masters Degrees from Purdue University. She served as Interim Pastor at North Highlands Presbyterian Church (now Grace) of Ft. Wayne, Indiana.

Barbara's favorite spiritual practices include playing her folk harp, gardening and caring for her flock of laying hens. She was married 26 years before being widowed. She has two grown sons, one of whom is married and gave her two granddaughters.
