3. Cost: Total cost is \$555 (\$575 for 18+ years). Presbytery will cover first 1/3. The church is expected to cover 1/3, and the individual is expected to cover 1/3 which amounts to \$185 or \$192 for 18+. Payment is due by November 1, and more information about how to make payments will be forthcoming.

4. Pre-Triennium Get-togethers: Mark your calendars for **February 22, 2019** and **June 15 from 10a.m.-2p.m.** These will be opportunities to connect, make a group covenant, and have fun. Site churches have not been chosen, but if you are a leader at a church that is central-ish in the Presbytery and would be willing to host one of these dates, please let us know!
