- 5. The WVP Nominating Committee is current receiving applications from clergy and ruling elders within the Presbytery who are interested in serving as a General Assembly commissioner.  - ✓ Commitment to continued service to the presbytery and its congregations including reporting to Presbytery and to meeting with congregations/sessions upon request after General Assembly.
 - ✓ Diversity and geographic distribution concerns within the presbytery.
 - ✓ Preference will be given to applicants from different congregations in successive General Assemblies.
