The death, disability, and retirement benefits of the Board of Pensions are established based on the assumption of participation in Social Security. When Board benefits are combined with Social Security benefits, pastors and their families can anticipate sufficient income to avoid a dramatic decline in standard of living should anything happen to the pastor. This is particularly true for younger pastors with families; Social Security benefits are essential for providing sufficient income for raising the children if anything happens to the pastor. Any person who has chosen not to participate in Social Security does so understanding that full responsibility for the financial well being of their spouse/family is theirs and theirs alone.

The Presbytery of Whitewater Valley has informed the pastor and congregation (through the PNC) that should anything adverse happen to a pastor not covered by social security, the Presbytery will IN NO WAY ASSUME ANY FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS FOR THE PASTOR THEIR FAMILY, OR THEIR SURVIVORS other than to facilitate claims for accrued benefits provided by the Board of Pension."
It is hoped that pastors who have opted out of Social Security will consult with their Session and with the Presbytery to insure that alternative income streams will be available should they become disabled, die, or retire.
